

Introduction

The dictionary is accompanied by the **Activity Resource Book** which includes 52 graded activity sheets, photocopiable flashcards and illustrated song and chant actions.




How to use the dictionary



The topic

 Ask the children to look for the hidden object and then say the word when they find it.



The dialog

- Play the CD and have the children listen to the dialog.
- Play the CD again and have the children repeat the dialog along with the CD.
- Have the children practice the dialog with you, taking turns to say part A or part B.



The song or chant

- Play the CD and have the children listen to the song or chant.
- Play the CD again and have the children point to the objects they hear in the song or chant.
- Break the song or chant into small sections and have the children practice.
- Play the CD and have the children sing along.
