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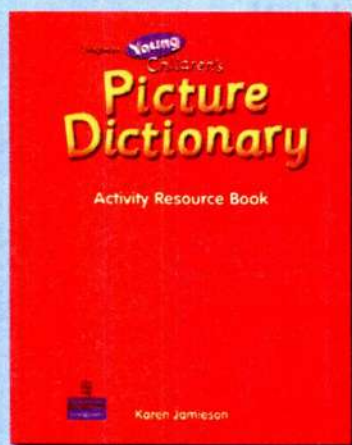
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Introduction

The **Longman Young Children's Picture Dictionary** has been designed specifically for children aged 2–5 and can be used both in the classroom and at home.

The 270+ words featured in the dictionary have been chosen to help young learners describe the world as they see it. Words are presented in context through 26 age-appropriate topics with engaging songs and chants and simple child-centered dialogs.

The dictionary is accompanied by the **Activity Resource Book** which includes 52 graded activity sheets, photocopiable flashcards and illustrated song and chant actions.



How to use the dictionary

The topic

- Before looking at the scene, talk briefly about the topic (in the children's first language if necessary) and ask if they know any English words related to this topic.
- Let the children point and say the words for objects they recognize.

- Have the children practice the dialog with you, taking turns to say part A or part B.

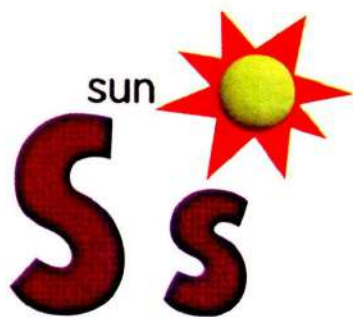
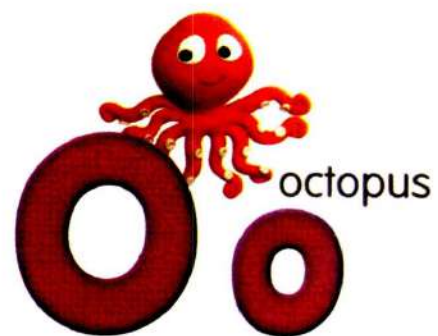
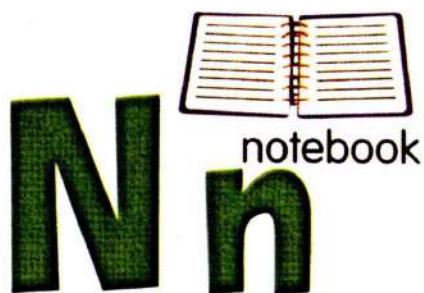
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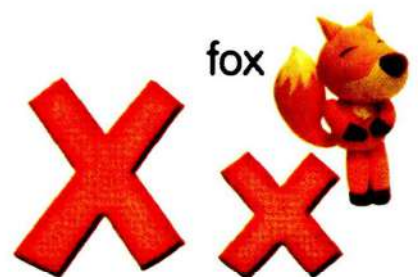
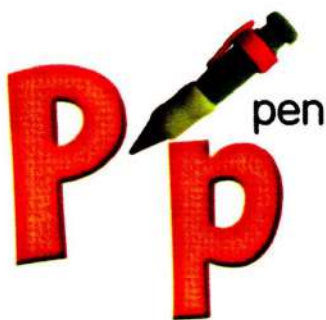
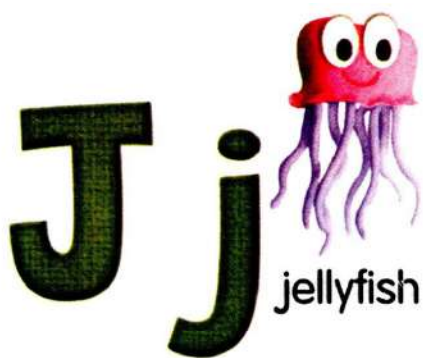
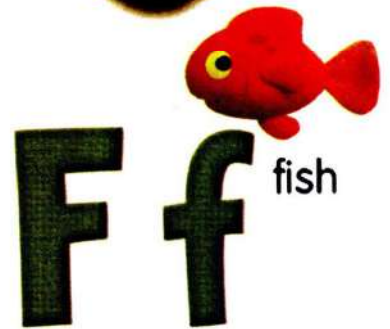
